Source of Funds

The State provides funding for each SELPA based on the bed count data for group home and foster pupil count data that were used in the prior fiscal year. Funding for Community Care, Intermediate Care, and Skilled Nursing facilities is based on pupil count data collected by the Department of Developmental Services as of April 1st of the current year for children and youth ages 3 to 21.

Funding Allocation

Effective 23-24, the Superintendent's Coordinating Council will be reviewing the OOHC funds to determine revisions to the allocation plan.

Prior to 23-24, OOHC was allocated based on SCC decisions in the 2016-17 school year.
