The Sacramento County SELPA and the 10 member districts believe that all students need to meet high standards of academic knowledge and skills. In addition, they must have the ability to apply their skills to the workplace, where they will be required to adapt to emerging technologies and changing societal needs. The SELPA and member districts recognize that content and performance standards are necessary to clarify for students, parents/guardians and staff what students are expected to know and be able to do at each grade level and in each area of study. Student goals and objectives on their individual IEPs shall be based on the state content standards whenever appropriate.

POLICY

It shall be the policy of the Sacramento County SELPA and the member districts to comply with the requirements of the performance goals and indicators developed by the state and provide data as required by the state. A review of the LEA performance goals and indicators is made on at least an annual basis to determine priorities for program improvement.
